

**CITY OF PARK HILLS
INFRASTRUCTURE AND PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES FROM THURSDAY, APRIL 11, 2024 MEETING**

1. Amsterdam Road

The Committee discussed timing for both the Amsterdam interim fix and deep fix. Since the meeting, the interim fix is underway and engineering for the deep fix is set to begin in May. The Committee will ask Mayor Zembrodt to work with Police Chief Cody Stanton on a traffic maintenance plan for the deep fix.

2. Traffic counts

The Committee is still working with Clerk Julie Alig on the historical data traffic count data. Since the meeting, the new traffic counter strips have been deployed on Park Road in both direction and data is beginning to come in. The initial results (as of 5.1.24) show there were 2,000 trips recorded on Park Road in a 28 hour period.

3. Road survey report (Mayor Zembrodt and Councilmember Elkins)

The Committee reviewed and updated the current color-coded road survey with Mayor Zembrodt. The Mayor also updated the committee on the FY24-25 road plan. The Committee decided to NOT ask Mayor Zembrodt to retain Bayer Becker for a new road survey (estimated cost: \$6,300) and instead ask Bayer Becker to update the color coding of the current road survey. In the meantime, Councilman Shields is updating the road survey to combine all information into one document.

4. Mt. Allen green screen (Mayor Zembrodt)

There was no update provided for the green screen.

5. Brent Spence Bridge Subcommittee (Councilmembers Elkins and Shields)

Councilmembers Elkins and Shields will report on their efforts at the next Committee meeting.

6. Update: Reflective paint on North Arlington sidewalk (Public Works Director Von Handorf)

Mayor Zembrodt is working with Public Works Director Dan Von Handorf on this.

7. Old State Road gate (Mayor Zembrodt)

The gateway sidewalk and gate from Old State into Park Pointe is being installed.

8. New business

No new business brought up.
