CITY OF PARK HILLS INFRASTRUCTURE AND PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES FROM THURSDAY, AUGUST 8, 2024

1. Review and approval of minutes

The minutes from the July Infrastructure meeting were reviewed and approved.

2. GPS misdirection

The City has not aggressively attempted to contact the various GPS map providers (Google Maps, for example). Councilman Shields will share this information with Stacee Hans at KYTC.

3. Traffic count

Dan VonHandorf shared the following traffic counts. All counts are over a 24-hour period and cover both lanes of traffic:

- St. Joseph Lane: 1,948
- North Arlington: 1,286
- Cleveland at Park Road: 612

The next streets to be monitored are St. James and South Arlington. The counts will be repeated once school starts to provide a snapshot of traffic when schools are both in and out of session.

4. North Arlington Sidewalk

Mr. Jenkins was not able to meet with Mayor Zembrodt and Jay Bayer about this issue. He'll try to do so before the next Committee meeting.

5. Connectivity on Dixie at North Arlington

This pertains to the section of Dixie Highway between North Arlington and the first business/concrete pad going north. While several approaches were discussed, a course of action was not determined. In the meantime, Mr. VonHandorf will get prices for a rock-and-pipe approach.
